### **1. Introduction**

### **2. Importing:**

1. Importing Quicktime movies,
2. Convert iPhoto movies to iMovie events.

### **3. The iMovie Interface:**

- What buttons/menus mean and do. View options for browsers and libraries.

### **4. Organize Your Event Library:**

1. Setting browser preferences
2. Mark and sort footage with favorite, reject and unmark. Creating in and out points.
3. How to use the advanced tool to mark and sort footage.
4. Split events to separate imported tape. Adjust the date and time for clips.
5. Assigning Keywords to Footage.
6. Working with the inspector to adjust clip, video and audio settings.

### **5. Create and Edit Projects:**

1. Creating a new project. Project Properties Window.
2. Adding clips to a project. Covers multiple methods to select and all clips to a project.
3. Drag and Drop editing. How to perform, replace, cutaway and PIP edits.
4. Precision Editing. Use the precision editor to fine tune transitions.
5. Clip Trimming. Remove or add to clips in a project. Frame by frame editing.
6. Crop Video. Adjust 4:3 video for a 16:9 display
7. Use Markers to add chapters or for collaboration.
8. Editing Audio. Separate audio from a video clip for editing.

### **6. Titles, transitions, maps and Themes.**

1. Transitions and Titles. Adjust transition time. Set fonts for titles.
2. Maps and Backgrounds. Create zoom effect after animated map. Combine background and a title.
3. Adding a Theme. Access custom theme transitions and titles.

### **7. Sharing and Exporting.**

1. Share and export to disk. Share to iTunes, iDVD or a folder.
2. Sharing to the web. Share to YouTube or MobileMe. Remove shared project.

### **8. Advanced Project Samples.**

1. Creating custom graphics for titles or transitions.
2. Advanced Slideshow example. Edit durations, transitions, add video transition, beat markers.
